

Now accepting applications for the College of Professional Studies Student Emergency Funding Award

The purpose of this award is to support the educational endeavors of undergraduate and graduate students within the College of Professional Studies (CPS) who are facing financial hardship, including unmet need and financial emergencies.

<u>Guidelines</u>

- Applicants must be currently enrolled as a degree-seeking student in CPS.
- Students may only receive funding once per academic year. Priority will be given to students who have not received support previously.
- Students must be in good academic standing.
- Requests may not exceed \$2,500.
- Students must disclose if they are receiving funding from other University and/or external sources.
- Only requests for emergency funds which involve a one-time, unavoidable expense will be considered. The fund cannot cover long-term or continuous situations.
- Priority will be given to students with the greatest demonstrated need.
- Selected recipients will receive their award as a tuition award applied directly to their GW student account.

Application Process

• <u>Applications</u> for the spring 24 semester should be submitted by no later than **Monday**, **February 5** and will be reviewed by a committee of faculty and staff appointed by the Dean. After the initial deadline, applications will be considered on a rolling basis but awards will be subject to availability of funds. Applications must be complete, with all required supporting documentation provided, before they will be considered by the committee.
